Sir,

With reference to that portion of your letter of the 19th ultimo, which deals with the purchase, in connection with the mill property, of a road machine from ~~the~~ Sawyer Massey & Co, of Hamilton, I beg to say that the Department approves of your referring the account back to the Six Nations Council (which passed a resolution to have the account paid from band funds) in order that the resolution passed in the matter may be amended so as to cover the interest on the amount due from the 1st October. When sending the account to the Department you should state whether the purchase was authorized by the late Indian Superintendent.
