I was trying to make him understand all this I'm telling you now, and the Chiefs asho Mr Pagget, and Indian Agent Brown if they all agree to sign up, to put all my children on the Robinsons Treaty, again they asked him if it would be all right and Pagget says, Yes, but its up to your Boys the less money you will get, so there wasent any thing more said of it till now I would like you to make me understand all; and say my children will get in Robinsons and Entrenes money, at least the Entrenes money any way. Please, dont refuse.
