I was trying to make him understand all this I am telling you now. and the Chief who Mr Pagget. and Indian Agent Brown if they all agree to sign up. to put all my children on the Robinsons Treaty. again they asked him if it would be all right and Pagget says Yes. but its up to your Boys the less money you will get. so their wasn't any thing more said of it till now I would like you to make one understand all. and say my children will get in Robinsons and Entrance money. at least the Entrance money any way. Please don't refuse.
