I paid No. 12, Hoho, -- 6 --, this summer, as Mr. Bourassa assurred me that he was the right person.

Re Nos. 39 and 40, I was unable to ascertain their previous Band numbers - not having tickets -, and as they claimed to have received Treaty before, I paid them, in 1924, giving them tickets under above numbers. I could not find out their names.
