



I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 21st ultimo, in regard to the question of issue of patent for right of way of your company through the Miyuke Indian Reserve, in the Province of British Columbia, and in reply ^{I am directed} to say that the Department is not disposed to issue patent unless the British Columbia Government consents, in writing, to waive its claim to the reversionary interest in the said land.
