


Ottawa, November 9th., 1918.

Sir,-

I beg to say that the Department is in receipt of a letter dated 4th instant, written by Louis Lamorandiere from Parry Island, in which he states that he received payment of four shares of interest money this fall, but that he was not paid for his youngest child, a girl born on the 18th June last. He adds that the child was baptized by the Rev. Father Cadot, of Cape Croker and that he wrote you in the matter but that you failed to enter her on the pay-list. The Department desires a report from you in this connection. If Lamorandiere's statement is correct, you should make application for the share of interest due him for this child.
