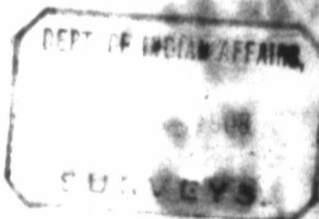
Sir.-

I have the honor to forward herewith a letter, dated the 22nd ultimo, received from Mr. Agent Irwin, of the Kamloops-Okanagan Agency, B. C., covering an application, of the 15th ultimo, made to him by the Sno-hosh Water, Light & Power Co. for permission to construct an irrigation ditch across the Deadman's Creek Indian reserve.
