Dear Sir,-

This is to inform you that the sentence of the Standing Court-Martial by which you were tried, on the 14th June 1945, has been reviewed. It has now been directed that the portion of the sentence "To be discharged with ignominy from His Majesty's Service" which was awarded by the Court be remitted. As a consequence thereof the reason for your discharge from the service is, therefore, being amended to read "Services being no longer required".

May the Discharge Certificate issued to you at time of discharge be forwarded to the undersigned. On receipt of this a new Certificate will be issued showing the amended reason and despatched to you. In addition, if as a result of your service, you have earned a War Service Badge, this will also be forwarded to you.

As the matter of War Service Gratuity may or may not be involved, this matter will be referred to the Paymaster-General, National Defence Headquarters, for whatever action is indicated.
