Portuguese, and Danish, 33 of that number being volumes; making the whole number of publications issued by the Society at its House, excluding the Periodicals, 5,955; of which 1,233 are volumes, the remainder paper-covered books, tracts, leaflets, cards, and handbills.

The whole number of publications at foreign missionary stations, approved by this Society's Publishing Committee, and issued wholly or in part by its funds granted for this purpose, is 4.211, of which 640 are volumes.
