PROVINCIAL LUNATIC ASYLUM.

Two and a-half miles west from the City hall, on Queen street. The property is vested in the Crown. Government appoints medical superintendent, bursar and inspector. The latter frames by-laws for its government, thoroughly examines the asylum, and reports to the lieutenant-governor. The admission of patients is regu-

lated by the Act 16 Vic, chap. 188, which requires that the patient be examined by three licensed medical practitioners, verified by reeve or mayor, collectively, who certify to the insanity. Application, for admission must be made before sending lunatics. Idiots, and persons afflicted with paralysis, are inadmissible.
