COLBORNE. An incorporated village
84 miles from Toronto on Keeler's creek
(which here falls into Lake Ontario and
affords power) and on the G T Ry in Cram-
ah township, Northumberland County, 15
miles east of Cobourg, the county seat. It
was incorporated in 1858, and has four flour
mills, a foundry, a pottery, and other in-
dustries, and contains two Methodist, and
Presbyterian, Episcopal and Baptist church-
es, a public school with 250 pupils, a public
hall seating 400, a bank, and has two weekly
newspapers, the *Northumberland Enterprise*
and the *Express*. Assessed valuation of real
and personal property, \$270,000; no bonded
indebtedness. Grain, produce and the pro-
ducts of the manufactories are shipped.
Telephone facilities. Steamboats call daily
for the lake ports and run tri-weekly to
Charlotte, N Y. Daily stage to Hastings,
25 miles north, fare \$1. Population, 1,200.
