A Review.

"THE MARSHLANDS," By J. F. Herbin, Wolfville, N. S. Such is the title and such the author of the volume before us.

"The purpose of my pictures would not show. Only that life hath pleasure for the eye. My lines would point the way into the heart."

Such the poet states to be the purpose of the volume; it behooves us to see how far he has carried this out. Characteristically patriotic, his first poem is "Acadia," wherein he says well:

"This is a land of legend; every mount a story has, would hoary shades recount. There is no valley, marsh or misty shore, Without the charm of mystery and lore—Where rivers mate with wonder yet might tell."

Following this poem is a number of sonnets, one of which, "A Dream," is in our mind really beautiful, a real poetic gem whose lines "point the way into the heart of all their glory."

"A sunbeam fell upon my drowsy eyes; And soon within my veins it fluid gold With glad monitions through my loins rolled."

"The melodies seek not the past nor seek futurities." "This is a life that feathered things beyond unattempted songs and heights of sky."

"The piece, 'Return,' is written in that Ovid-like metre so well handled by Browning. Though this form of verse is very difficult, yet Mr Herbin has used it with good effect and considerable strength."

"A lover of his country at first, his love continues and widens and at the end it strikes his harp to 'Fair Canada of legend and of song.'" "Thou land of promise, youthful and brave. Fair Canada of legend and of song. My destiny's bright star not guide thee wrong."

Public Schools. The following notes are published for the information of trustees and teachers. Recent changes in the law make these notes necessary at this time, and it is hoped that all concerned may find them useful:

ANNUAL MEETING. (a) The Annual Meeting will be held in all sections on Monday, June 20th, inst. (b) Written notices of this meeting, signed by the trustees, should be posted in three public places, in the section, five days previous to the meeting. (c) The election of a trustee to fill the annual vacancy and the voting of money for the varied school purposes of the section are among the things necessary to be done at this meeting.

ANNUAL RETURNS. The present provisional year closes July 7th, and contains 166 days. Every section that has had a school in operation for the whole or any part of the year is required to send an Annual School Return to the office of the Inspector of Schools not later than the 14th of July.
