SOME STATISTICS OF NANAIMO

Valuable Reference Is Made to Nanaimo in the Current Number of the Financial Post.

Through the efforts of the Nanaimo Industrial Development League, Nanaimo is being written up in the current issue of the Financial Post, whose western manager was a visitor to the city a few weeks ago. The Financial Post is one of the most influential financial journals of Canada, largely subscribed to by investors in Canada and Great Britain and publicity in the publication will be immensely valuable to the city. Special boosting copy is not for sale in the Post, which makes its references to this city all the more beneficial.

The Post in part says: "With the employment of a commissioner by the Nanaimo Development League, that city on Vancouver Island will now become more than a name on the map as one expressed it.

"The city of Nanaimo is so situated on a splendid natural harbor as port of the island. Statistics for the month of March show a marked increase in coastwise as well as for to make it an important shipping sign shipping.

"The city limits include but one square mile with a population of 8,500, but on account of a suburban population of between two and three thousand a petition will be presented to the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council to permit the city to extend its boundaries, to include at least the three square miles in which this suburban population lives. Already the suburbs are served with city water, and have light and telephone service, the street lighting extending only to the present city.

"The Western Fuel Company near the city where they are 500 acres under cultivation, and which is used to raise the fodder for the animals employed in the company's mines. Here farming is carried on along most up-to-date methods, and a good profit is shown at the end of the year.

"The chicken ranch of Messrs. Skinner and Blenkhorn just outside the city limits demonstrates how this industry can be made profitable. Six thousand chicks at one hatching were produced from a series of incubators heated by hot water. The demand at the coast cities for fresh eggs and dressed fowl assures the success of this industry.

"The history of Nanaimo dates back to 1868, when the Hudson's Bay Company built a bastion there, which is now one of the old land marks. The city was incorporated in 1875.

"The distance from Vancouver to Nanaimo is 36 miles, and the traffic during the summer is so heavy that the Canadian Pacific Railway last year put on a passenger steamer that makes the trip in two hours and during the tourist season makes two round trips a day.

"The development of Nanaimo and the district of which it is the centre and distributing point, is shown in the customs collections for the fiscal year which ended on March 31, which totalled \$166,365.39, an increase of over \$28,000 over the collections for the previous twelve months and constituting a record in the history of this port.

"The collections for the year in each sub port of the district were as follows: Nanaimo, \$94,270.17; Alberni, \$48,344.96; Courtenay, \$567.96; Comox, \$7.28; Cumberland, \$29,479.37; Ladysmith, \$5,248.68; Port Alberni, \$8,467.96; Union Bay, \$9,448.43; Ocean Falls, \$2,438.52.

"The collections for March, the last month of the fiscal year were the largest of the entire twelve and were as follows: Nanaimo, \$5,735.58; Alberni, \$1,968.29; Courtenay, \$29.61; Cumberland, \$6.64; Ladysmith, \$285.59; Ocean Falls, \$112.49; Port Alberni, \$205.57; Union Bay, \$3,494.57; and Comox, \$7.28—total, \$18,988.52.

"The building permits issued during the month of March were \$32,000, an increase of 200 per cent. over the returns of March of last year.

"The city has 17 miles of concrete sidewalks and one mile of paved streets, 14 miles of sewers and water pipes with 1800 individual services.

"Three miles of paved streets at a cost of about \$300,000, will be laid this year.

"The ratepayers have approved of an expenditure of \$20,000 for motor-

driven fire apparatus, and an electric alarm system.

"The industries of Nanaimo include the largest coal mines in the province, lumber mills, sash and door and box factories, brick yards, powder works, etc., with a total pay roll of over \$300,000 per month.

"The recent development of Nanaimo has been such that suitable business premises and dwellings are hard to secure. This probably accounts for an increase of over 200 per cent. in the building permits for March over those of the corresponding month of last year.

"The country surrounding Nanaimo is well adapted to mixed farming and poultry raising, the climate being most suitable for the latter."

MONTENEGRO DEFIES AUSTRIA

Little Kingdom in Balkan Alliance Will Hold Scutari at all Costs Is Reply to Austria.

London, April 24.—"Take immediate combined action to turn the Montenegro out of Scutari or we shall do it alone," declared a circular sent by the Austro-Hungarian government to the powers today. The note is regarded as an ultimatum.

Austria-Hungary declares she cannot permit the Montenegro to flout the decision of the great powers. The prestige of the European nations has been violated, says the note and Austria-Hungary demands that the powers decide promptly on the steps to be taken to restore that prestige, adding that if the powers should be unable to reach a speedy decision she will see to it herself that the will of Europe is respected and that the Montenegro vacate Scutari.

Cettinje, April 24.—"Scutari from today is Montenegrin," was the defiant reply today of King Nicholas to the European invitation to surrender the hard-won Turkish citadel.

The King made this statement in the course of a speech delivered from the balcony of the royal palace. Among his audience were the ministers of the Balkan states who came to congratulate him. He added: "Should (Continued on Page 3).
