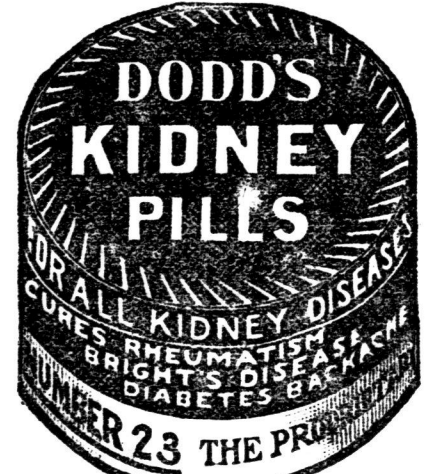
No Trace of Sex.

MACHINERY HALL HAS VERY MANY VISITORS

Transportation Building Is Also a Very Attractive Feature of the Fair.

Possibly no building at the Fair is the centre of more general interest than the Machinery Hall. The farmer may want to see the horses and cattle and the races and the dogs and chickens, but if there is one thing more than another that he does want to make sure of seeing, it is the latest improvements in gasoline engines, cement mixers, sugar-making machinery, patent churns, fireproof roofing and farm implements of all kinds, and it is in the Machinery Hall that he finds them. Without seeing all these things he would have missed the Fair, and probably the most valuable half of it. It is the same with the city man. He may be only out for a good time, a holiday or a rest, but he can combine them all and receive a good deal of instruction of a distinctly valuable nature in his ramble through the building devoted to machinery. That the women who attend the Fair are also interested is shown by the crowds who are constantly to be seen in front of the splendid exhibits of stoves and ranges, hardware displays and demonstrations of all the latest devices for interior painting, removing dirt or sanitary appliances. In order to be up-to-date on all these things, a woman can't afford to miss seeing these things and nine out of ten take good care that they do not miss them.

An Attractive Place.

Recognizing thoroughly the importance of the Machinery Hall, the directors this year decided to make it more attractive than ever, and in addition to building a wing at the west end which has increased the space available for show purposes one-fourth, they went after all that was best in the way of interesting and suitable exhibits. Their efforts have been amply rewarded, and every visitor to the Fair after he or she has been through the building has a word of commendation for the enterprise the board has shown, and of praise for the very excellent class of exhibits that were obtained. Never in the history of London Fair has there been a better show or a variety of really useful articles that appealed to so many people. There is something for everybody, and that something represents the best in its line. It is a pleasing fact for Londoners to be able to point out the very high place that goods made in this city occupy among those that are shown. London firms are showing lines that are made here exclusively and are in demand from coast to coast, and again there are instances where the London manufacturer is side by side with other leading Canadian firms, and it is no small source of satisfaction to know that the goods not only size up with those made in other places, but are in demand.

Machinery Hall is a busy place morning, afternoon and evening, in fact it is perhaps the busiest place in all the busy exhibition. Its nearest rival for interest being the Main Building.

Immediately surrounding the hall on the outside is a very fine display of threshers and farm implements, wire fence, metal roofing and similar lines that are of particular interest to farmers and those who have buildings to care for and wish to learn about the best.

Transportation Building. Just west of the Machinery Hall is the Transportation Building, filled from end to end with as choice an assortment of high-grade vehicles of all kinds as ever graced a Canadian fair. Manufacturers from all over the country here are inviting the inspection of here they are inviting the inspection of the public interested in methods of transportation. Here you will find the classiest automobile that has been produced during the year, an endless array of buggies, carriages, surreys and similar vehicles, the heavy farm wagon built for hard and heavy work, or the sulky in which the racehorse will win because of its lightness in weight. If there is one thing more noticeable than another in the Transportation Building, it is the uniformly high quality of the goods. There are as many different kinds of vehicles as

there are manufacturers, yet every individual vehicle is a finished article, and Canadian firms may well be proud of the excellence of their products. Here again London firms are noticeable. Their goods take second place to none, and in many instances as their exhibits are considerably larger than those of their outside competitors, they have displays that are striking in proportion and show that they are leaders in design and workmanship.
