PROGRESSIVE CZAR ANXIOUS TO ASSI

Henry Wise Wood Believes Alberta Farmer Members Will Co-operate.

NO ELECTION NEED Message of U. F. O. Chief Indicates Opinion That King Should Carry On.

Special to The Advertiser. Calgary, Nov. 4.-In the light of the present political situation in Canada a statement made by H. W. Wood, president of the United Farmers of Alberta, and head of the Farmers' political movement, in the current issue of the U. F. A., provincial party organ, is of considerable importance. In the past Mr. Wood has always taken the stand that the Farmers' representatives in the federal house cannot co-operate with any political party in the house. Now he departs from this stand and suggests that the U. F. A. (Alberta Progressives) members-elect will stand ready and anxious to assist any party in legislative efforts in the interests of industrialism as a whole. He indicates the opinion that Premier King should carry on the government in co-operation with the U. F. A. and other independent representatives in

the house.
"The U. F. A. elected members to represent the basic industrial interests of the country and of civilization," writes Mr. Wood. "They do not want their industrial interest exploited by any other interest, nor do they want to exploit any other interest. What they do want is to meet representatives of all other legitimate industrial interests in co-operative effort to legislate in the interests of industrialism as a whole

Ready to Co-operate.

"Other industrial interests," he continues, "have not seen fit to send such representatives, but have consigned their interests to the keeping of a political party. While no political party has ever dealt intelligently or fairly in legislating for industrial interests without favor or discrimination, the U. F. A. members will stand ready and anxious to co-operate with and assist any party in such legislative efforts.
"On this basis, and this basis only,

can any party justly ask and receive such co-operation." This is taken to mean that the

nine Alberta Progressive members are willing to co-operate with Premier King, should he decide to carry on the government, in al legislative efforts which do not conflict with the principles on which they were elected.

Earlier in his article, Mr. Wood says: "One serious problem that is facing us in the immediate future is how a legislative group on a strictly non-co-operative basis is going to function with less than a majority of all legislative members. Will this all legislative members. Will this group recede sufficiently from its iron-clad position of non-co-operatin to hold out the olive branch of cooperation to some of the smaller groups or independent individuals who stand on a co-operative basis? Or will it take the attitude that it will unalterably stand on the basis of competition, and will not undertake the responsibility of governing ninating to that end proceed to call anothe

Would Mean Many Elections,

Mr. Wood appears to be of the opinion that Premier King should carry on the government, seeking to co-operate with the U. F. A. repre-sentatives and other Progressive and Independent members. He goes on to say in answer to his question: "This might lead to a series of elections extending over an indefinite period, with no definite change in results. The whole situation is a perfect exemplification of the hope-lessness of the present false political party system."

"The U.F.A.," says the president of that organization, "has elected enough representatives to give the

enough representatives to give the larger groups the necessary assistance to carry on. These members were elected on a strictly co-operative basis. They are being sent to parliament for the purpose of co-operating with any or all other groups in the interest of constructive legislation, and will stand ready as legislation, and will stand ready at all times to respond to any appeal for co-operation, but that co-opera-

tion can only be given on the merits
of the legislation that is offered."

This appears to be a pretty clear
statement that Mr. Wood believes that Premier King should carry on with the government, and that a basis of co-operation should be reached between the federal U.F.A. members and the Liberal party.
