London, Nov. 15.—A despatch from Lord Kitchener dated from Pretoria today says that a strong patrol of Yeomanry while reconnoitering November 13 at Brakspuit, near Zeerust, in the Transvaal colony about 140 miles west of Pretoria, was surrounded by 300 Boers and lost six men killed and 16 wounded.

London, Nov. 15.—A despatch from Lord Kitchener dated from Pretoria today says that a detachment of 100 Dutchmen playing the part of traitors, who had been captured near Helbron, on November 14, by 400 Boers, said to be under the command of General Dewet, after two hours fighting the Boers retired, leaving eight dead on the field.
