Line Will Open Up Large Country Rich in Timber and * Gold

WILL TRAVERSE MANY CREEKS

Authorities State That There Are No Serious Construction Problems

After crossing the Fraser river at Quesnel the new railway will enter a district associated with an enormous district associated with an enormous production of placer gold in early days, the value of which will be outclassed in a very few years by the operations of the hydraulic mining companies. For a distance of seventy miles it will traverse the banks of rivers and creeks whose riches were household words in Victoria a few years ago, and from whose golden sands came the money that built many of the large old-time residences of the city.

Four-mile creek will be crossed above the Quesnel townsite and then the Quesnel river followed for four or above the Quesnel townsite and then the Quesnel river followed for four or five miles. This brings the railway to the 240-mile post from Waddington harbor. After a detour to the north, touching Cottonwood river in one place, and by a turn to the south crossing it near its course, Lightning creek will be encountered. This tributary of Swift river has been a large producer of gold in the past, and is now being worked with success by improved latter-day methods. Lightning creek will be followed until, on its right bank, Beaver pass is entered. This divide is about 300 feet higher than the surrounding country, and.
