

- A joint Canadian government and aerospace industry program provides pilots from Canada and several NATO countries with classroom instruction and flight training on advanced aircraft at Canadian Forces bases Moose Jaw and Cold Lake.
- CIDA has a \$90 million budget for the countries of Central and Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union. The funds support the transition to market-based economies, increase Canadian trade and investment links (notably through the Renaissance Eastern Europe Program), and promote democratic development.
- Canada has led several arms control related missions, including Operation Verify and Operation Question missions. Canada also participated in a number of NATO and other internationally sponsored arms control initiatives in Europe.
- In 2000, Canadian Forces personnel from all three services took part in 13 exercises as part of the Partnership for Peace program. Introduced in 1994, the program is proving a valuable tool for fostering relationships between NATO and non-NATO countries and for enhancing stability and security throughout Europe.
