## TO ATTACHMENT B

## Escapement Objective for and Harvest Sharing of Canadian-Origin Yukon River Chinook Salmon

- Subject to paragraph 16 of this Chapter, the Parties agree that the spawning escapement objective for the rebuilt chinook salmon stock in the Mainstern Yukon River shall be 33,000 to 43,000 chinook salmon.
- Harvest of Mainstem Yukon River chinook salmon shall be shared beginning in
  2001, and continuing until amended by the Parties, on the following basis:
  - (a) when the Total Allowable Catch (TAC) is between zero and 110,000 chinook
    salmon, the guideline harvest range for Canada shall be between 20% and
    26% of the TAC;
  - (b) when the TAC is above 110,000 chinook salmon, the guideline harvest range for Canada shall be between 20% and 26% of 110,000, i.e., 22,000 and 28,600 chinook salmon, plus 50% of the portion of TAC greater than 110,000 chinook salmon.
