The Secretary of State for External Affairs today announced the composition of the Canadian Delegation to the Third Session of the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization which is to open at Beirut, Lebanon, on November 17, and is expected to end on December 11, 1948. Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

The Conference will study the proposed programme and budget of UNESCO for 1949 and will deal with other questions including the election of a successor to Dr. Julian Huxley as Director-General.
