value; and lastly the estimated operating and inventory loss. These columns are then totalled and a figure of \$9,800,000 odd is arrived at for storage charges. Each column is totalled, and the estimated inventory loss amounts to \$48,458,986.

Mr. Diefenbaker: What were the storage charges?

Mr. McIlraith: In round figures, \$9,880,000.

Mr. Danforth: Does that give us the same breakdown and detail on the values themselves or on the operating loss?

Mr. McIlraith: It shows item by item in detail.

Mr. Danforth: The complete inventory?

Mr. McIlraith: Yes. I think this should answer all the questions asked.

The Chairman: Is it agreed that this information be printed in *Hansard* as part of the minister's remarks?

Some hon. Members: Agreed.
