

Also,—List of Leases, Licences, Permits or other authorities cancelled under the provisions of R.S.C. 1927, chapter 113, section 96.

Also,—Ordinances in the Northwest Territories passed in accordance with provisions of Revised Statutes, 1927, chapter 142, section 13.

Also,—Return of Orders in Council which have been published in *The Canada Gazette*, in accordance with the provisions of section 75, chapter 113 of "The Dominion Lands Act," R.S.C. 1927.

Also,—Copies of Orders in Council which have been published in *The Canada Gazette*, in accordance with the provisions of section 4, subsection 3, chapter 130, R.S.C., "Migratory Birds Convention Act".
