COPY THE RHODES TRUST London, July 23rd, 1926 Dear Macdonnell, Kingston Military College With reference to your letter of June rather 30th, it seems to me a question /for Canada - or Canadian authorities - to answer, whether a course at the Military College can reasonably count as equivalent to two years at a degree granting institution. If a course at the Military College of any given length is accepted by the recognized Canadian Universities as equal to two years with them, them I do not see why the Trustees should not recognize the same course. If the College can be brought under the Memorandum it is not in the interests of the Trust to exclude it. West Point is accepted in the U.S.A. What is Kingston's standing in University circles?
