## (ONSTITUTION.

1. 'Lac title of this Society in "Tin Methorolitan Sochety for the: Puevention of Cucelty to Animals."
2. Its ohject shall be to provide effective means for preventing Cruelty to Animals in Ottawa City, and the surrounding Counties.
3. Any person may beeome a Member of this Society by paying the sum of not less than tivo dellars as an annual subscription. The name of any member neglecting ior one year to pay his subseription, or nt any time wholly refusing to pay it. may be erused by the Committee from the list of members. The Committee may, from time to time, elect patrous and honorary members.
4. The Committe, consisting of thirty members, who shall mannge all the affinis of the society, shall be elected at the Anmual General Mectiog of the Socicty, on the third Thursehy in August. They shall appoint from among themselves a President, six Vice-l'residents, and Secretary-'Irensurer, who shall be ex-nfficio Members of the Committee, and may also, from time to time, appoint such other officers, and make such Rules or By-laws as they may think fit, provided that these rules be not inconsistent with this coustitution. They may also fill any vacmacies that may oceur in any offices of thu Socicty, between one annual mecting and another.
5. The Annual Meeting of the Socicty shall be held on the thind Thursday in August, when the outgoing Committee shall present a general report of the procecdings of the Socicty, and an abstract of the state of accounts and generul concerns of the Society up to the lst day of August previous, and the Committee for the ensuing year shall then be elected by ballot or nomination, as may be decidel on at the meeting.
6. A Special Meeting of the Society may be held at the call of the Committee, and shall be held upon the written request of five members of the Society, a weak's notice of the meating being given by the Secre-tary-Treasurer.
i. At all mectings of the Society, seven Members present, (who have pail their subscriptions,) shall constitute a quorum. Five memhers shall constitute $n$ quorum at meetings of the Committee.
7. Any Article of this Constitution may be altered, ameduded, or suspended for any length of time ly consent of two-thirels of the mem-
