luable, that we could not possibly quarrel with any power, with a greater probability of advantage.

A Spanish war at this period, would be attended with fewer ill consequences than at any other time. At present it would involve us with no other nation; but were we at peace with France, we should in all probability fee her join the Spaniards; and fuch a power coming fresh into a war with us, in the situation which France was in before the present troubles, would be extremely different from Spain's joining France at present. The court of Madrid could not have chosen a more impolitic, a more unfavorable moment to attack us.: she can now have no affistance that will be of any service to her. In the last war the French were in a very different situation from what they are in at present. Then their fleets in a great measure protected the coasts of Spain; but how are the times changed! Now the fleets of Spain
