To accomplish this Purpose, the most infallible Means would be, to look back, and minutely confider our Conduct, fince our first Communication with them, and then to resolve, for the future, to act in every Article diametrically the reverse; a Scheme, which with Difficulty will be put in Practice, unless the greatest Regard and Attention is paid to the Characters of the feveral Governors, and Commander in Chief, who are fent over to that Continent. I include the Commander in Chief, because the Nature of his Office, and the Extent of his Power is fuch, that the best Measures of the most accomplished Governors, might be defeated by his Ignorance or Perverseness.

As Mr. Amberst, I am informed, is returning home, (a Circumstance much to be lamented, by the Colonies universally, and C 2 more
