FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF

SETTLERS' EFFECTS

From all Canadian Pacific Railway Stations and from all
Grand Trunk Railway Stations to principal points in

MANITOBA and the CANADIAN NORTH-WEST

A.— A Carload of Settlers' Effects, within the meaning of this tariff, may be made up of the following described property for the benefit of actual settlers, viz.: **LIVE STOCK**, any number up to but not exceeding **TEN (10)** head, all told, viz.: Horses, mules, cattle, calves, sheep or hogs;



HOUSEHOLD GOODS and personal property (second hand); WAGONS, or other vehicles for personal use (second hand); FARM MACHINERY, IMPLEMENTS and TOOLS (all second hand); LUMBER and SHINGLES, which must not exceed 2,500 feet in all, or the equivalent thereof, or in lieu of, not in addition to, the lumber and shingles, a PORTABLE HOUSE may be shipped; SEED GRAIN; small quantity of TREES or SHRUBBERY; small lot LIVE POULTRY or pet animals; and sufficient feed for the live stock while on the journey.
