An affidavit was filed by Hill was produced, but after a portion had been read it was objected to by prosecuting counsel. The affidavit is dated Feb. 9, and in it Hill declares that prior to the assignment of the fishing rights to the British Government, he had been approached by a man who offered him a large sum of money to purchase the fishing rights.
