Sir:-

By an agreement made between your department and this company, on the first of December 1890, it is provided that, for the maintenance of peace at the point where the railway crosses the Indian reserve at Indian Lorette the Station Master is to be appointed a Magistrate, and such number of Indians as may be considered necessary are to be appointed Dominion constables.

The Company would beg respectfully to request that Maurice Bastien, Grand Chief, and Francis Grosblouis and Gaspard Picard Pere, Chiefs, may be appointed Dominion constables for that purpose.
