

He in childhood showed much artistic tal-ent and on reaching manhood at once pro-ceeded to the study of art. He became a member of the artistic circle in Paris and from 1864 until 1870 he was a recog-nized member of the group of talented scholars of the famous sculptors Barye and Carrier-Belleuse. In 1870 he went to Brussels and worked under the instruc-tions of Van Rasbourg for seven years. Since then he has resided in Paris. Among his famous works are busts of Victor Hugo, Balzac, Rochefort and Mirabeau. 




