A stirring address was last night delivered by Rev. Dr. D. S. Chown, superintendent of the Canadian Methodist churches, at a meeting in Centenary church when he dealt with "Patriotism and Conservation." He would like to see the 274,000,000 pounds of foodstuffs "now being wasted in the manufacture of liquor in Canada" saved to the empire. He dealt interestingly on the subject of conservation and patriotism in turn, and in referring to the latter among other things said: "I would that

there were no graft today in Canada. But there are people acting a part more contemptibly in Canada today than the crews of the German submarines in sinking women and children." Dr. Chown was followed with appreciative interest, at which there was a large gathering.

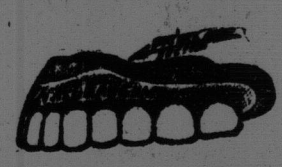

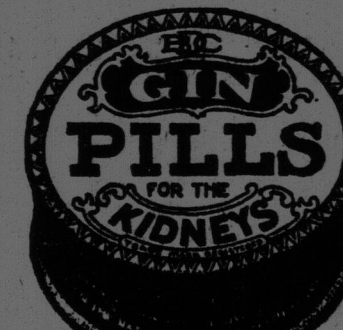

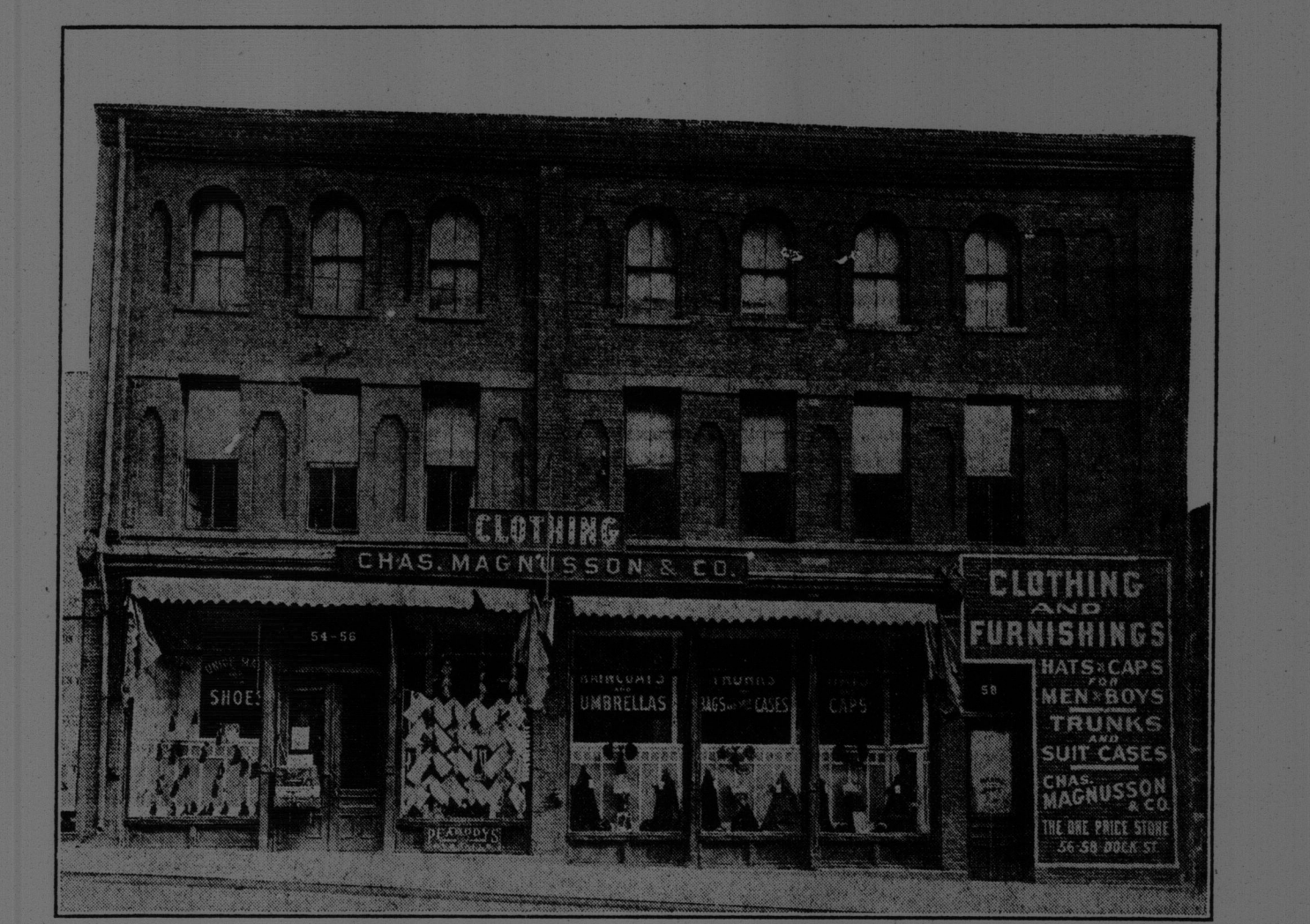
