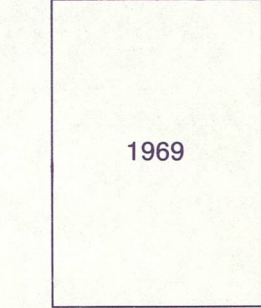

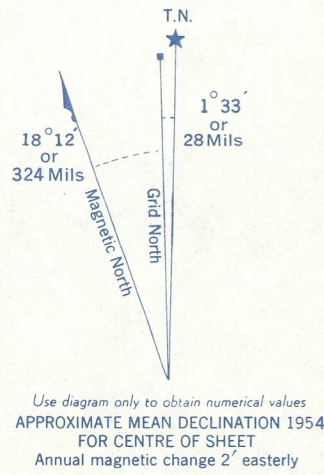
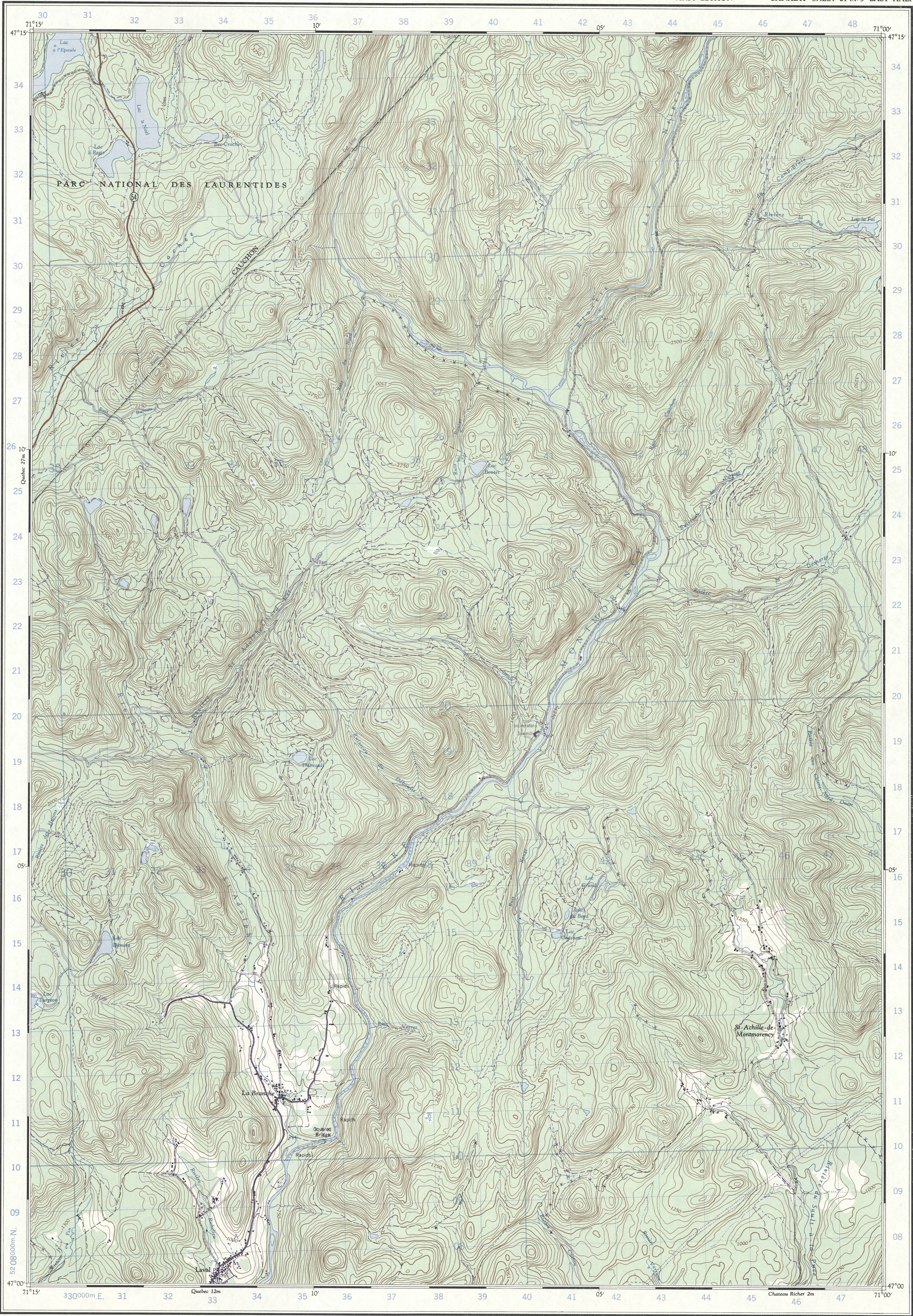

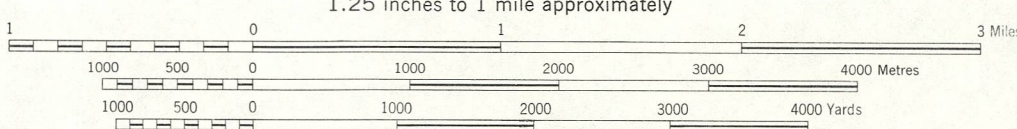

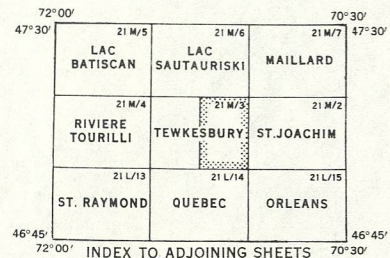
CONVERSION SCALE FOR ELEVATIONS
