### IN THE POLICE COURT TODAY.

Two prisoners were handed out a strong temperance lecture and almost the limit penalties in the police court this morning.

Wm. McIntosh, an innocent looking stranger, was charged with being drunk and shouting on Charlotte street and was fined four dollars or ten days.

Joseph Dixon, an old offender, was charged with being drunk and profane on Mill street. He was fined four dollars or ten days for the drunkenness and eight dollars or two months for the profanity.

Wm. Swanton was the subject of a severe lecture for becoming intoxicated and was told that the next time he appeared in court he would be treated under the Dominion Act and sent to jail for six months without a fine.

"The spring has arrived and young men should brace up, get to work and give up rum."

John McDonald, a vagrant, was for the second time in three days charged out of court and robbed of some easy meals and shelter in the jail. He was informed that the city did not want the like of him and the best thing he could do was to get out.

Wm. Morrison, who only recently got out of jail, was fined \$2 or two months for being drunk. The magistrate said that the prisoner had a wife and family to look after here tonight and that he should be sober and get to work.

The answer will be "Dead." These men here are only taking the places of the unfortunates who have dropped out. The best work we can be engaged in is to stop these people from drinking rum to poor unfortunates, and when they get drunk dump them out."

Michael McFadden was fined \$8 or two months for being intoxicated.

Amce Campbell said that he had been drunk. He belonged to Little Melic, Que., and arrived in the city on Friday, visited a place where he believed he had been drugged. It was the first time in 25 years that he had been intoxicated and it would be the last. He was fined \$8 or one month jail.

Oscar Nelson, a Norwegian sailor, with others of the crew of a bark, were intoxicated on Britain street Saturday evening. The other members of the crew went on board the ship, but Oscar was stubborn and was so sorry this morning that he was allowed to go by paying a four dollar fine.

Edward Kennedy said he lived up to the country and came to the city on Saturday to purchase some dry goods, but obtained a bottle of wet goods instead. He was sorry and would like to get back home. He was fined \$8 or twenty days jail.

### FALLS FROM ROOF,

GRIES 'HELLO, MA'

Millon Holz, Four Years Old, Surprises Frantic Women After Plunge of Six Stories.

NEW YORK, April 5.—Millon Holz, four years old, of No. 64 West 135th street, went up on the roof of the six-story apartment house adjoining that in which he lives yesterday afternoon to play steam cars with his little sweet-heart, Florence Kirkland. They rigged up a truck on the coping and were having a splendid time when the engine failed to work. In trying to fix it the little playmates pushed the cars over toward the edge of the coping that they could not reach them. Milton, with all the fearlessness of four years, climbed up on the rail, and before Florence knew there was any danger plunged headlong from the roof.

Florence screamed as loudly as she could. She ran down through the apartment crying that Milton was dead, and never stopped till she got to the Helix apartments next door. Mrs. Helix heard the commotion and was waiting in the hall to hear what it was all about.

"Milton, he just fell off the roof next door," the excited Florence, who was screaming and started for the vacant lot in the rear of the apartment house. Twenty other women reached there at about the same time to help, as they thought, pick up the shattered body of little Milton.

Milton was sitting up between two jagged rocks which had been blown out by a blast from a neighboring excavation. In his hands he held a battered locomotive and two steam cars.

"But, Milton," gasped his frantic mother, "Milton! don't you hurt?"

"I got a little on my finger," said the child, pointing to a slight scratch.
