Board, \$2.50 per week.

Laundry, (12 plain pieces), 25 cents per week.

Room rent, lighting, and heating, \$6.00 to \$12.00, de-
pending on the choice of room.

Tuition in English, 40 cents a week.

Tuition in Higher Mathematics, Science, Classics, and
Modern Languages, 80 cents a week.

The total expenses for the Fall Term of 14 weeks, in
unselected room, in English, is \$50.10. For Winter and
Spring Terms, each is \$43.70, or \$137.50 a year.

Add to this the rate for best average room and Tuition
in Higher Mathematics, Science, Classics and Modern Lan-
guages, and the amount is \$157.90.
