

RAIN MARS THE BIG  
FAIR AT BANGOR, ME.

Gray Bobby Wins 2.27 Pace  
and Day Q. Three Minute  
Trot.

**WORLD'S POWER BOAT RECORD.**  
Minneapolis, Aug. 29.—A new world's  
record was established by Miss De-  
troit II, driven by Gar Wood, Detroit,  
in the second of a series of three  
thrust races for the Gold Chal-  
lenge Cup of the American Power  
Boat Association. She covered the  
distance with an average speed of  
46.4 miles per hour. Her average,  
which also was a record, was 50.7  
miles per hour.

On the first six-mile lap she aver-  
aged 59.5 miles per hour, the fastest  
time ever made for the distance in  
competition over a measured course.

**WORLD'S FLIGHT RECORD.**  
Paris, Aug. 29.—Capt. Guilo Lau-  
rami, an aviator in the Italian army,  
has established a new world's long  
distance flying record by flying more  
than 500 miles without stopping, ac-  
cording to a despatch to the Temps  
from Milan. The Italian flew from  
Turin to Naples and return, a dis-  
tance of about 520 miles as the crow  
flies.

Capt. Laurami used a new Si-  
mone machine. He left Turin at 10.07 a. m.,  
reached Naples, flew over that city  
and was back in Turin at 8.40 p. m.

"MUGGYS" FINED \$1,000.  
New York, Aug. 29.—John J. Mc-  
Graw, manager of the New York Sun  
ball club, was today fined \$1,000,  
suspended and reprimanded by the  
board of directors of the National  
League, for approving an interview  
subsequently published, containing an  
attack upon John K. Tener, president  
of the league.

**THREE HELD FOR DEATH**  
**OF CHIPMAN RESIDENT**  
John Bishop, Sydney Pyne and Man-  
ley Stillwell, of Chipman, have been  
sent up for trial on the charge of un-  
lawfully killing James Bishop of Chip-  
man on July 15 last. The information  
and complaint was laid before the  
police magistrate in Chipman by  
Claude Bishop, brother of the deceased.

Wm. R. Scott represented the com-  
plainant. It will be recalled that Jas.  
Bishop came to his death in being  
thrown into deep water from a boat,  
which, it is alleged, the defendants  
rocked "to make him swim."

The death of Bishop occurred on  
July 15 in Salmon river. The accused  
and deceased were out in a raft boat,  
and it is alleged the accused rocked  
the boat until it filled and they all  
went into the water. Bishop was  
drowned.
