WEIMAR GOVERN TO ATTACK RE STEADILY LOS

Establishment of New Regim from Body Politic is Expe

Paris, April 12.—(By the Associated Press).—Germany is one country in the enemy coalition in which the American commission to negotiate peace maintains no information service. A special mission sent to Germany during the early days of the conference to provide the commission with reliable news of the political developments was withdrawn in March.

Thus the Peace Commission is without direct information concerning developments at Munich, Magdeburg and other storm centres in Germany.

The press reports announcing the proclamation of a soviet republic in Bavaria, a corresponding movement in Northern Germany and the arrest of Minister Landsberg, the intellectual leader of the majority socialist government group, are taken by those studying German political conditions as symptomatic of what is to be expected in case the present government fails—namely, the establishment of a new regime, based, not, like at present, on universal suffrage and democratic elections but upon the action of the proletariat and the elimination from the body politic of the bourgeois population.
