public opinion that it is now no longer considered to be "odd," or "Puritanical," or "over-scrupulous," to be a pledged total abstainer. and we doubt not the time is near when it will be deemed to be honourable (though not a distinction, so numerous will be our recruits,) to belong to the Temperance Army. It is our earnest hope that in the coming year we may be enabled more vigorously to carry on this work which has been begun in faith, and carried on in a spirit of dependence upon Him whose own cause we believe this to be, and who, we feel assured, will put even this enemy under His feet.
