

consisting of all the Members present during the Session, is appointed. At the beginning of every other Session, Prayers are said; new Members are introduced and sworn; some Bill is read *pro formâ*; the Speech from the Throne is reported, and the Committee of Privileges is appointed. -

Call of the House.

4.—On the Second Friday, after the commencement of each Session, The House is called, and notice is taken of such Life Members as are absent without the permission of Her Majesty, or of the Governor of this Province, signified to The House; and on this occasion The Committee of Privileges reports to The House, the names of such Life Members as may have died since the last Session, or who may appear to have vacated their seats, by absence or other causes.

Clerk's accounts.

5.—At the commencement of every Session, The Clerk is to lay before The House, on the day following the appointment of the Committee on Contingent Accounts, and as often thereafter as he may require an advance of money, a detailed account of his disbursements since the last audit, with vouchers in support thereof.

Tickets of admission.

6.—On the days of the Opening and Prorogation of Parliament, no Stranger is admitted without a ticket of admission.
