Dear Sir:

I duly received your letter of 18th August last in regard to the Company's right of way through the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 24-20-15 West 2nd, Pasqua Reserve. I received letter from Mr Joseph R. Miller, who stands in the Department's books as the purchaser of the quarter section, in which he states it will not be convenient for him at the present time to pay to the Department the amount of principal and interest required before patent for the right of way can be issued to the Company. Mr Miller has guaranteed to make payment at a future date on behalf of Mr William J. Smith from whom the Company purchased the right of way. I presume that although payment of the required amount cannot be made at this time, the Department will not object to registering the enclosed Quit Claim Deed from Mr Miller to Mr Smith and also enclosed transfer by Mr Smith to the Grand Trunk Pacific Branch Lines Company.

The right of way in these documents is described by reference to plan filed in the Land Titles Office as No. 2010-A.L., a copy of which I presume has been registered by the Department. If you can register the documents please advise me and amount of your fees which I will remit.
