Dear Sir

The Indians at the Fisher's Grant reserve are asking urgently for more land. They want more land for cultivating and more wooded land for fuel. William Scott of Pictou Landing is offering a piece of land of some thirty or (36) acres for \$400, four hundred dollars. This land is adapted for crops. Mr James A Sproule is selling 50, fifty acres of wooded land at \$20.00 per acre. Both these tracts of land are adjoining the reserve & most conveniently situated for the Indians. This matter was brought up before I trust the Department may see its way to doing something in the matter this year.
