Camp Borden, Ontario	17-8-42		<p>At 0800 hours ceiling unlimited, visibility 8 - 10 miles, wind 4 - 6 m.p.h. S.-S.W. Overcast to the North, slight haze to S.E. Flying washed in at 0800 hours and continued until 1730 hours. Night flying organized and carried out at Edenvale and Camp Borden.</p> <p>Total flying time 416.35 hours.</p>	
	18-8-42		<p>Soft Ball game at Camp Borden between Barrie Girls and W.D. Teams.</p> <p>Flying washed in at 0830 with ceiling unlimited with ground haze - becoming worse in the afternoon. Wind variable, 15 - 25 m.p.h. Flying carried on 4 hours dual and 4-1/2 hours solo until 1730 hours. Night flying organized for Camp Borden and Edenvale but washed out on account of meteorological report.</p> <p>Total flying time 232.55 hours.</p>	
	19-8-42		<p>Air Vice Marshal G.O. Johnson, Air Officer Commanding No. 1 Training Command, visited this unit on an official inspection tour. All personnel on the station were inspected on the drill square followed by a march past.</p> <p>The grounds and building were inspected. The lack of a hospital and the dilapidated condition of the medical inspection rooms was noted. It was suggested that building A-122 be temporarily converted to a hospital and medical inspection rooms.</p> <p>Ceiling unlimited, visibility 2 - 3 miles in heavy haze, gradually getting worse. Wind S.W. 15 - 32 m.p.h. Flying began at 0815 hours and washed out at 1200 hours. Instructor's instrument flying carried out from 1430 hours - 1730 hours. Night flying organized but cancelled.</p> <p>Total flying time 132.30 hours.</p>
