The Whitley Report has laid down a principle which will have far-reaching & beneficial effects - described as "Constitutions for Industries." - The main effect of these principles, which in the earlier of Whitley, is applied to the Dominion (Honourable) states that the worker has a right to a voice in the Provincial Parliaments in the last set up in South Africa. They shall be not give the white man here at least a voice in fixing the conditions under which he shall carry on his daily life - anything which will in crease the man's interest in his work & bring him & the employer more into human touch with one another. There shall be a Council of representatives brought in and standardized.
