(b.) If you have not served in His Majesty's Forces, attach Exemption or Rejection Certificates, and state how employed since March 1916.

8. Give reasons in full for wishing to leave the United Kingdom. Satisfactory evidence will be required as to the object of the proposed journey. Employees of firms or persons acting on behalf of firms must produce certificates from their employers as to the business on which they are proceeding abroad
