THAT to assist in the maintenance of national unity and to preserve in Canada the largest possible measure of co-operation between all classes and sections of the country in the winning of the war, it is desirable that before effect be given to the provisions of this Act a further effort should be made to meet the requirements for overseas service by voluntary enlistment, under a plan of national organization which will have a due regard to Canada's resources and needs, and which will promote a just apportionment of the burdens of the war between all classes.
