with reference .. your application a grant of land for the school at Lac la Plonge, I beg say that the land in question has not been surveyed as and cannot, therefore, be homesteaded or sold. There no objection, however, to your having the land taken improved, and when the survey is made your claim in rethereto will be liberally dealt with.

As regards your application to accommon to be utilized in connection with an electric 1: plant which you desire to have installed, I have to set that every applicant for power privileges is required file with the Minister of the Interior a statement in plicate setting forth * -

- (a) His name, residence, and occupation.
- (b) The nature and location of the business, pl manufactory in connection with which it is posed to utilize the water power privileges
