Ottawa ,14th December, 1909,

Sir,

I beg to inform you that Inspector Ramsden in his report bearing on matters connected with your Agency has stated that a unanimous resolution was passed by the Indians to the effect that they be permitted to expend \$500.00 in building $6\frac{1}{2}$ miles of fence around their reserve. In this connection the Inspector refers to trespass upon the reserve and remarks that you stated at a meeting that the Indians have \$1,000.00 to their credit from C.P.R. Right of way payment, which is the fund from which they desire to draw the \$500.00 above referred to.

The Department desires to receive from you without delay a definite report in the matter stating when the \$1,000.00 referred to was paid.
