Sir.

With respect to the suit entered against your father, Thomas White, and yourself by your brother, Matthew White, for the hay which it is alleged you wrongfully took from his land, and further with respect to your request that the Department have some officer investigate the title to this land, I beg to say that from the information that has been received from the Agent with respect to this land it appears to the Department that your brother, Matthew, has the best claim thereto. If, however, you still claim the ownership of the land from which this hay was taken you will have an apportunity to prove your claim when the comes on for trial. Any evidence that you may have to support of your contention should be produced at the trial.
