This is a large task. It will not be completed in a year. Perhaps not in generations. Nevertheless, to press on towards the goal of social and economic freedom is the great task of Liberalism. Of recent years, much has been accomplished. Old age pensions, pensions for the blind, unemployment insurance, floors under farm prices, family allowances: all these are examples of measures introduced by Liberal Administrations. But something more is needed than remedies for social disabilities and economic misfortunes. Prevention, where possible, is always better than cure. What are most needed are policies to encourage production, and enterprise and trade, a high level of employment *formation from the period* of transition from the war to peace, these have been foremost among the objectives of the Liberal Party in Canada.
