

SECOND WITNESS

A 9048 Cpl AKIENS L.W. having been duly sworn states.

I am E A 9048 Cpl AKIENS L.W. F Sec 13 Provo Cdn Army at approximately 0100 hrs 23 Dec 44 I was coming along the roundabout and saw a provost jeep. There were soldiers around and I presumed it to be our own men and drove right on.

On reporting to my Headquarters I mentioned to Sjt Harding of seeing a Provo jeep in the roundabout, which appeared to be having trouble. He asked me whose it was and I replied that I had not noticed. Sjt Harding then checked for his own vehicle and found it to be missing. Sjt Harding and I then ran to the roundabout and gave chase to a soldier ~~xxx~~ that was running away, I never did catch the soldier.

The evidence is read back to the accused.  
The accused declines to cross-examine the witness.
