## Provincial Platform of the Grand Army of United Veterans

- 1. A comprehensive industrial scheme, embracing the development of the principal natural resources of the Province.
- 2. The establishment of an Old Age Pension Act for all workers over the age of sixty years.
- 3. The establishment of a complete Health Insurance Act, ,and the creation of a Portfolio of Minister of Public Health.
- 4. The establishment of an efficient Public Utilities Act with powers to investigate and if possible, control, within the Province Food Prices.
  - 5. The Abolition of the Poll Tax.
- 6. The exemption from taxation of all estates under the valuation of \$5,000 of the members of the Canadian Expeditionary Forces for the period of their service overseas.
  - 7. Revision of the Municipalities Act.
- 8. The establishment of a 44 hour week in all industries not covered by special legislation, with a maximum of 48 hours in all industries.
- 9. Creation of National Reserves of Coal and Timber to prevent the present wasteful exhaust of these vital assets.
  - 10. Maternity benefits with free hospital services.
- 11. Free and periodical examination of the health and dentition of all children of school age, with free dental clinics and hospital treatment.
- 12. Free and compulsory education, including textbooks, with scholarships awarded for University Course in accordance with the attainments of the pupils.
